

## Schedule of Student Contribution Fees

### FBP30521 Certificate III in Baking

1. Student Contribution Fees are a student's contribution to the cost of their tuition.
2. BITA is obligated to collect Student Contribution Fees which are calculated at \$1.60 per nominal hour (as at 02nd August 2018) for each unit of competency delivered.
3. The total fee may vary according to the range of units selected.
4. Please note that Recognition for Prior Learning for any unit is charged at this same rate.
5. There is no fee for units that are resulted with CT - Credit Transfer.
6. These amounts are charged in accordance with the Queensland Department of Employment, Small Business and Training, User Choice 2021-2022 Policy ([https://desbt.qld.gov.au/\\_data/assets/pdf\\_file/0021/7824/user-choice-policy.pdf](https://desbt.qld.gov.au/_data/assets/pdf_file/0021/7824/user-choice-policy.pdf))
7. To apply for Concession Fees, which are calculated at 40% of the full fee, please refer to bottom of form.
8. Students participating in a school-based apprenticeship do not incur Student Contribution Fees while they are school-based.
9. FBP30421 requires 14 units of competency (9 core / 5 elective) to be successfully completed & demonstrated in order to achieve qualification.
